
Background Information


Signaling lymphocytic activation molecule (SLAM, also known as SLAMF1 or CD150) is a 70-95 kDa transmembrane gly coprote in that belongs to the immuno globulin gene superfamily. SLAM is constitutively expressed on peripheral and the superfamily of the sblood memory T-cells, T-cell clones, immature thymocytes and a proportion of B-cells, and is rapidly induced on naive T-cells after activation. SLAM is involved in T cell stimulation and cytokine production, and may play an important role in the regulation of immune responses to pathogens.


