
Storage Instructions

All the reagents are stored at 2-8°C. The kit is stable for 6 months from the date of receipt.


Background

MAPK8(Mitogen-activated protein kinase 8) is also named as JNK1, PRKM8, SAPK1, SAPK1C and belongs to the MAP kinase subfamily. MAPK8 is activated by dual phosphorylation at a Thr-Pro-Tyr motif during response to UV light. MAPK8 functions to phosphorylate c-Jun at N-terminal serine regulatory sites of Ser-63 and Ser-73, mapping within the transactivation domain. Phosphorylation of these sites in response to UV results in transcriptional activation of c-Jun. Primary antibody in this kit can recognize JNK1, JNK2 and JNK3.




Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffinembedded human placenta tissue slide using KHC2267 (MAPK8/JNK IHC Kit).
